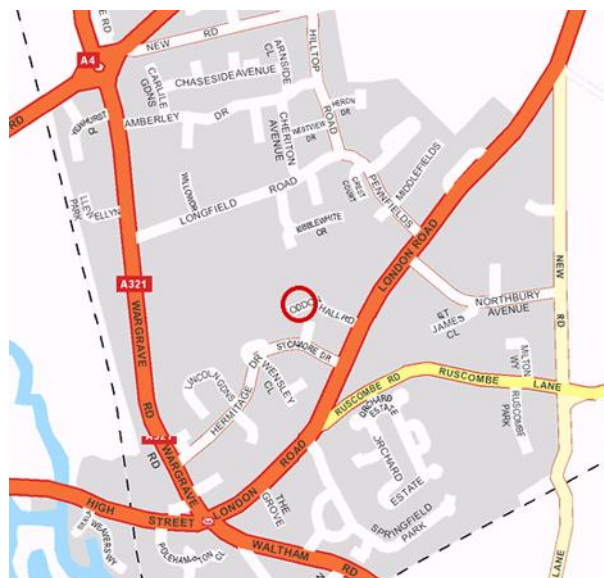

SUMMER DANCE COURSE

Who For?

The course is designed for all ability levels and is open to students aged 7 years upwards.

Where?

The course will be held at the Loddon Hall, Loddon Hall Road, Twyford. Further details of where the hall is situated can be found overleaf.

When?

The course runs from Monday, 25th – Friday, 29th July. Each day begins at 10.00am and ends at 3.00pm.

How Much?

£150 non MK School students, £120 MK School students, £110 for siblings & FYDC members

There is also an optional theatre trip to see ***The Wizard of Oz*** on Wednesday, 27th, July which will leave from Loddon Hall at 5.00pm. The cost is an additional £32 which includes theatre ticket, tea and coach fare.

What will I need to bring?

All participants will need to wear comfortable clothes which do not inhibit movement and bring jazz/ballet/tap shoes and trainers if you have them. Please do not purchase shoes especially for the Summer Course. A packed lunch will also be required.

COURSE AIM

The annual summer course has become a popular event in the school's calendar which is designed to give students the opportunity to participate in a variety of dance styles such as Musical Theatre, Latin American, Street Jazz, Ballet, Tap and Contemporary. In addition there are make-up and hair sessions, the opportunity to design and make props, plus learn the basics of lighting and stage management. The emphasis of the course is on fun and the enjoyment of participation.

The week will be taught by experienced teachers and choreographers and on the final afternoon the students will have the opportunity to show their work to family and friends.
